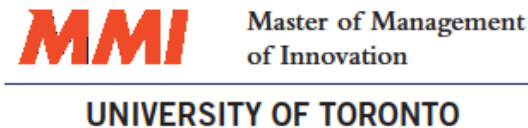
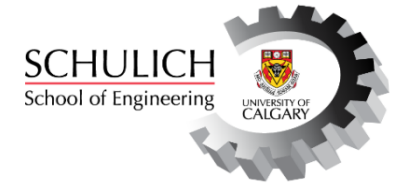

Student Work Placement Program (SWPP)

- 75% up to \$7,500 wage subsidies to hire students
- **Connects** employers, students, and post-secondary institutions.
- Work-integrated learning (WIL) opportunities
- Increase student's job-readiness

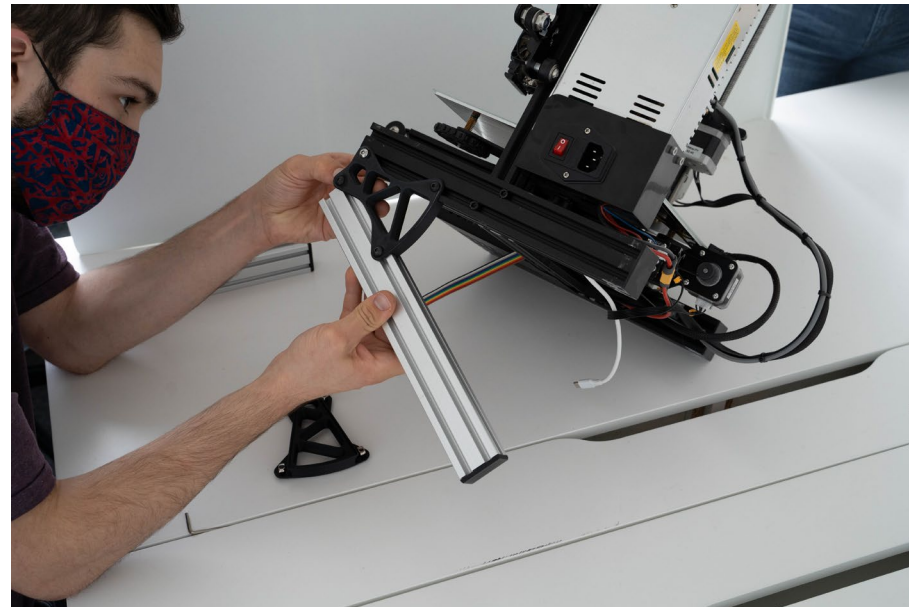

SWPP **Employer** Eligibility Requirements

- Provide full-time or part-time employment up to a max. of 16 weeks.
- Bio-economy or healthcare employer *and/or* job function.
- Wages cannot be combined with another federal program. (e.g. IRAP, Mitacs, NSERC, etc...)
- Student must be added to the employer's payroll.

SWPP – COVID-19 Updates

(until March 31, 2021)

- “Net New” / baseline of students hired eliminated
- 75% subsidy after May 25, 2020 ≤ \$7,500
- Pre-approval of employers and jobs
- 75% advanced payment
(SMEs - employers <500 not post-secondary institutions)
- Students can work from home
- Post-secondary institutions can hire their students
- Flexible start dates

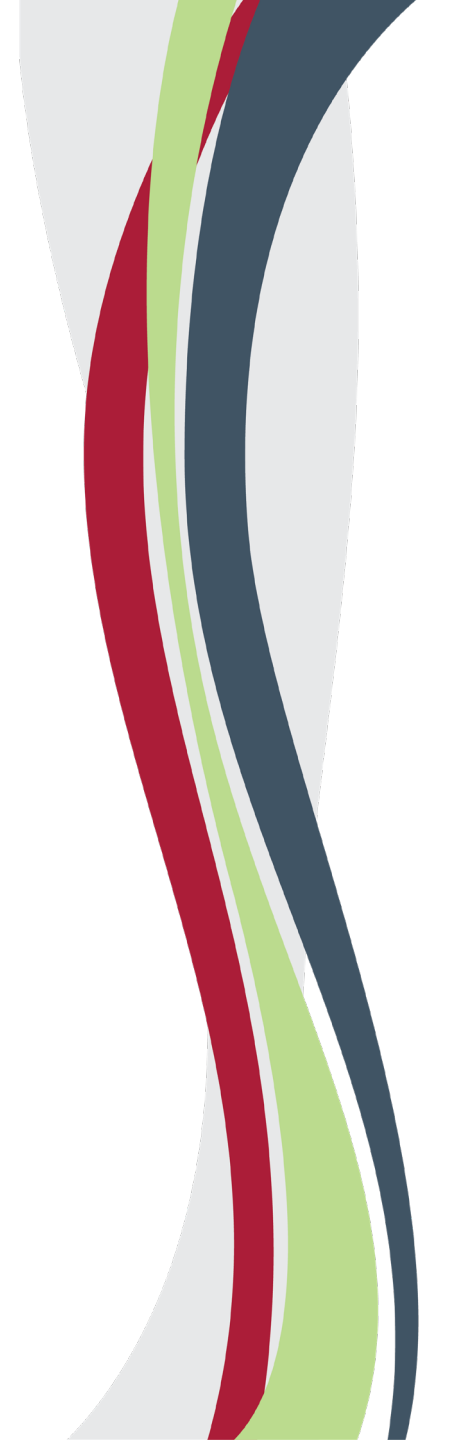
