

Phase I Projects

Since the last edition, **6 more** "400-series" COWIL initiative projects were approved for a total of 74 Phase I Projects.

Completed Projects


Out of 74 projects, 33 are complete as of October 2021. Completed project budgets spent so far amounts to \$3,131,193.

In November 2021, ACE-WIL will be hosting the second symposium to showcase the outcomes of the completed projects.

Ongoing Projects

The majority of projects will be wrapped up by the end of 2021. Final reports are due to the ministry one month after project funds are expended. The graph below gives an overview of the number of project final reports that will be due by month. By December 2021 most projects will be complete with their final reports due by the end of the next month- in January 2021.

Phase II Projects

In June 2021, the BC Ministry of Advanced Education (Ministry) announced an additional \$5.5 million in funds towards the COWIL Initiative. Proposals were submitted and the Ministry approved 46 projects at 25 different public post-secondary institutions in BC.




> 3000 WIL Placements

For Phase II, the Ministry put placements as a top priority for approval of funding. Over 3000 WIL placements were estimated in the phase II project proposals.

Themes

Other than creating more WIL Placements for students, Phase II projects focus on a variety of different areas such as equity, diversity and inclusion and small businesses.


Projects focused on EDI and/or Small and Medium Enterprises(SME)/Non-Profit Organizations (NPO)




Continuations of Phase I Projects

Why is it important to upload resources to the hub?


It is important to ensure that the outcomes of COWIL projects leave a legacy, are openly shared, and contribute to a provincial-wide WIL community of practice.
