



#### Hospitality, Tourism, and Culinary Arts Programs A Simplified Recruitment Guide

Use this guide to help you select which post-secondary institutions to recruit from for the hospitality, tourism, and/or culinary arts related positions you are looking to fill.

- The majority of student placements are paid positions requiring industry standard rates.
- Note that placements at schools listed under Tourism/Hospitality Management can include everything from entry level to supervisory roles, from operations and customer service, to sales and marketing positions.
- The sun (May-August), leaf (Sept.-Dec.), snowflake (Dec./Jan.-April), and/or clock (anytime) indicate when student placements take place. Ideally, recruiting students starts two months before the job's start date.

### Required Hours & Position Types

- Placements require between 40-500 hours
  - Most are 12-16 weeks (approximately 420 hours)
- Position Types:
  - Sales/Marketing: social media, group sales, marketing coordinator, etc.
  - Event Management: special event coordinator/assistant
  - Operations: entry level & supervisory roles, ie housekeeping, service staff, front desk, tour guides, retail, etc.
  - Culinary Arts: prep cook, 1<sup>st</sup> cook, 2<sup>nd</sup> cook, line cook, pastry chef, baker, etc.


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
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## Student Work Placement Program (SWPP)

- Federal program that gives post-secondary students across Canada paid work experience related to their area of study.
- Funding accessed through 18 delivery partners
  - Each has a different application process
  - and slightly different criteria as they serve different industries or position types.

#### **SWPP Eligibility & Funding**

#### **Regular Times**

- Up to 50% of a student's wages to a maximum of \$5,000 OR 70% up to \$7,000 if the student is from an underrepresented group
- Only Net New placements funded
- PSIs not eligible placements

## Covid Times (set to end March 2022)

- Up to 75% of student's wages to a maximum of \$7,500
- Net New
- Post Secondary Institutions are eligible employers

#### Work-Integrated Learning (WIL)

Co-operative Education and Work-Integrated Learning Canada (CEWIL) is the lead organization for work-integrated learning in Canada. They define work-integrated learning as a form of curricular experiential education that formally integrates a student's academic studies with quality experiences within a workplace or practice setting. WIL experiences include an engaged partnership of at least: an academic institution, a host organization, and a student. WIL can occur at the course or program level and includes the development of student learning objectives and outcomes related to: employability, personal agency, knowledge and skill mobility, and life-long learning.








Types of WIL





Employers update application once placement is filled







#### Who Qualifies?

#### **STUDENTS**

- Domestic (Canadian Permanent Resident or Citizen)
- Registered at a recognized Canadian postsecondary institution in a program that includes a work placement
- Program has Work-Integrated Learning (WIL) Component



#### Who Qualifies?

#### **EMPLOYERS**

- Tourism and hospitality employer and/or related to a tourism/hospitality job function
- On-site, remote, and hybrid placements all eligible
- Not funded by other federal grants or programs (including Canada Emergency Wage Subsidy [CEWS] and Canada Recovery Hiring Program [CRHP])
- Student must be hired as an employee of the company (not as an independent contractor)
