SUMMER 2021

- Identify your own eligible student or access pool of pre-qualified candidates
- New applications welcome + processed in late January 2021
- All funding paperwork is digital + can be completed quickly

EMPLOYER ELIGIBILITY

- Fewer than 500 employees
- Business, Social Enterprise, Non-Profit, Charity, Post-secondary Institution
- Located in BC, AB, SK, MB, QC, NB, NS, PE, NL or Territories

STUDENT ELIGIBILITY

- Canadian citizen, Permanent Resident, or refugee status
- Enrolled full or part time in an accredited Canadian college or university
- Studying any discipline, at any diploma or degree level
- Interested in entrepreneurship or seeking alternatives to 'traditional' job placements



KEY DATES + NUMBERS

- Subsidy is 50%, capped at \$5,000 or 70%, capped at \$7,000 (for students who identify as belonging to an underrepresented category), of wages + payroll contributions:
 - Required wage is \$15/hour or more
 - Paid on payroll
 - Full or part time allowed: no min. or max. hours per week
 - Internships cannot exceed 20 weeks to reach subsidy max.
- Half of eligible subsidy paid within 45 days of intern start



HOW TO PARTICIPATE

- 1. Complete an **Employer Application**
- 2. Register + attend Employer Eligibility Webinar
- 3. Deemed Eligible Employer
- 4. Identify your own Student OR Post to our Job Board
- 5. Student verbally accepts internship position
- 6. Employer submits **Hiring Request**
- 7. Funding approved
- 8. Funding contract and electronic paperwork submitted successfully
- 9. Half of allowable subsidy sent within six weeks of internship start date



VIRTUAL INTERN TRAINING

We're preparing students to add value in their internships right away, and orienting to the Future of Work with the input of great employers like you.

- All activities accrue points. 15 points must be accrued for future VFC participation. Students are notified when they meet this threshold.



STACKING OPPORTUNITIES

Our funder allows you to use other funding sources for the same student, provided the secondary funding is a non-federal source.

- Venture for Canada must remain your primary funder
 - Our process cannot be adapted for other funding
- Employer cannot profit from stacked funding
- Other funders who have indicated they can allow stacking with VFC:
 - Innovate BC
 - New Ventures (BC)


